### Do You Have Your Membership Card?

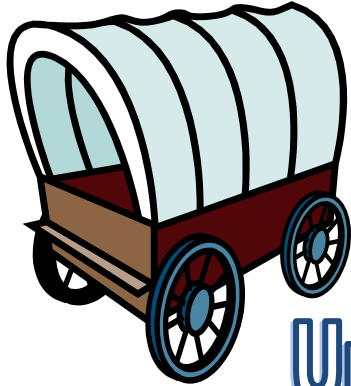
